

2014 JCADA Annual Report

JCADA's mission is to **SUPPORT** victims of domestic abuse to become empowered and obtain safe environments; **EDUCATE** community professionals and others about domestic abuse and appropriate responses to it; and **PREVENT** future generations from suffering domestic abuse by raising awareness.

SUPPORT

This year, the clinical team:

- supported 137 clients;
- responded to 110 helpline calls; and
- piloted a series of four-session art therapy groups in which clients spend time making art and engaging in discussions on topics that explore the themes of identity, self-compassion, and strength in community.



EDUCATE

This year we:

- launched JCADA's *13 Years of Being Here* recognition, engaging hundreds of people with various events throughout the year to raise awareness and funds;
- began planning our first-ever JCADA 5K Event: A Run, A Walk, AWARE; and
- co-hosted a successful Good Deeds Day program with Congregation Beth El with children, parents, and community members that included decorating cell phone collection boxes, a community art project and Zumbathon.



PREVENT

This year AWARE's prevention program:

- engaged 1,650 teens, parents and educators in workshops about healthy relationships and dating abuse;
- piloted *#healthyfriendships*, a workshop for middle school students focused on navigating tough friendship issues;
- trained 19 *It's Not Love* workshop facilitators; and
- presented *It's Not Love* as a Fairfax County Domestic Violence Network Tier Two Training to 20 domestic violence professionals and educators.

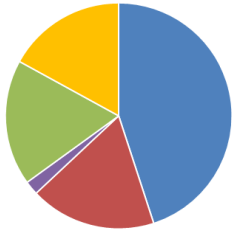

Revenue Sources FY 13-14

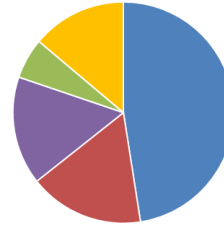
Total Revenue: \$585,836
